It was very sorry to hear

at Booneville that my horse had been  
foundered I think he should be sold  
as a work horse & should you  
find a fast running horse

as Nelson has lost my shoes

I fear we shall not meet so  
I have only to wish you health  
& prosperity the boat shakes like
