July 14th 1832

Dear Wife In good health and spirits I have arrived here
two thirds to my journey end. Six more and two others
deserted me and stole two horses. if he only please
meet him with the contempt he deserves 7 more have
deserted me since leaving me 12 men which is all
I want having got through all the dangerous country
I have had a bloody skin with the Black feet
Inds. by whom I lost 4 Horses I have got so far with a little
difficulty as I expected. you will not hear from me again
for some time and this letter must be short as the party
by whom it is sent must move on.
