

Photograph Duplication Requests

Requestor must fill out a Photographic Material Order Form. The requestor will list the following:

- Image requested
- The use or proposed use
 - Personal use (Copyright Fair Use rules)
 - Publication (Copyright permission required)
- When requesting a digital image
 - State dpi requested
 - State format requested

A Digital Image Exists

If a digital photograph exists as a high resolution image and the Museum holds the Copyright or the image is in the Public Domain, the request may be granted immediately if the use is compatible with the Museum's quality standards. A Permission to Publish Form will be filled out and signed by both the Director of the Museum and the requestor.

For images used in publications to which the Museum does not hold Copyright, the requestor is responsible for obtaining permission to publish from the copyright holder. The Museum will provide the requestor with instructions to this effect and request written acknowledgment in return.

A Digital Image Does Not Yet Exist

The Museum will need to create a new high resolution image of the object, photograph or document. This may take some time and the Requestor will be notified regarding the length of the delay.

If the Museum holds the Copyright or the image is in the Public Domain, the request may be granted immediately if the use is compatible with the Museum's quality standards. A Permission to Publish Form will be filled out and signed by both the Director of the Museum and the requestor.

For images used in publications to which the Museum does not hold Copyright, the requestor is responsible for obtaining permission to publish from the copyright holder. The Museum will provide the requestor with instructions to this effect and request written acknowledgment in return.
